



UPTP Paraguayan Students Interning at Master First Visit to Master's R&D Center, Production Line and Maintenance Depot

Master Group has selected 14 Paraguayan students currently studying in Taiwan at NTUST (National Taiwan University of Science and Technology) from UPTP (Universidad Politécnica Taiwán Paraguay). Starting from August this year until the end of the year, they will participate in off-campus internships at different sites under Master Group, based on their respective majors and learning goals. On August 1st and 2nd, they visited Master's maintenance depot, R&D Center, and the Production and Manufacturing site to gain an initial understanding of the group's business scope. These students from UPTP are considered promising young professionals in Paraguay. Through this internship, it is believed to enhance and support Paraguay's automotive industry in areas such as production and manufacturing, material procurement, procurement contracting, material distribution, configuration management, quality auditing, warehouse management, sales management, after-sales service and lifecycle product application control.
